Wesgreen International School was founded in 1991 in Sharjah, and in the years since it has grown to become one of the most successful schools in the area. The school is divided into four separate sections. The Early Years School from Nursery to Grade 1 is based in the Al Qarain Area. The Primary School accommodates students from Grade 2 to Grade 4. At the end of Grade 4, students move to either the Boys' or Girls' Secondary School. The Boys' and Girls' Secondary Schools cater for Grade 5 to Grade 13. Cambridge International A Level is the world's most popular international examination for 16-18 year olds. At Wesgreen, students are admitted to AS Level in Grade 12. A variety of subjects is offered including Art and Design, Physical Education, Applied ICT, Mathematics, three Sciences, four Business subjects and four Humanities for a desired combination.

As an international school, Wesgreen recruits and retains highly qualified and dedicated staff whilst providing opportunities to foster their professional and personal development. Currently we have staff from over 31 nationalities. The School promotes strong interpersonal relationships among administrators, staff, students and parents, creating a positive and supportive environment.
