Sherborne Qatar Senior School and Sherborne Qatar Preparatory School are co-educational British day schools modelled on the Sherborne schools in Dorset, England. The Prep caters for pupils in Pre-school to Year 6. The Senior School caters for pupils in Years 7 - Upper Sixth (Year 13). The Prep follows the National Curriculum with enhancements, in line with a number of leading prep schools in the UK. The Senior School prepares pupils for a full range of (I)GCSE examinations; and (I)A Levels. Both schools offer a wide range of co-curricular enrichment activities and opportunities, and all pupils are encouraged to play as full a part as possible in the wider life of the school.

Sherborne Qatar Senior and Prep Schools are both fully accredited to the UK DfE British Schools Overseas (BSO) and to the Council of British International Schools (COBIS). The Headmaster of the Prep is a member of IAPS.

Enquiries about the availability of places are always welcome. Admission to Sherborne Qatar is subject to passing an entrance assessment, and priority is given to British and first language speakers of English. All pupils must have a sufficiently good command of spoken and written English appropriate to their age.

Individually tailored tours of the school can easily be arranged at times to suit prospective parents.
